## International Training programme for Journalists to be held in Denmark

Applications are invited for the above mentioned training programme due to be held in Denmark next year.

Journalists attached to print and electronic media organisations, with three years experience are eligible to apply. As the course will be conducted in the English language, a working knowledge of the language and basic computer skills are minimum requirements.

The maximum number chosen for the programme will be twenty (20). Women journalists are strongly encouraged to apply to ensure a gender balance.

Participants will be short-listed by an independent interview panel and the final selections will be made the Danida Fellowship Centre in Denmark.

The programme is of five weeks duration. Air-fare and accommodation costs will be met by the Danish organisers and a per diem will be paid for food and other expenses.
